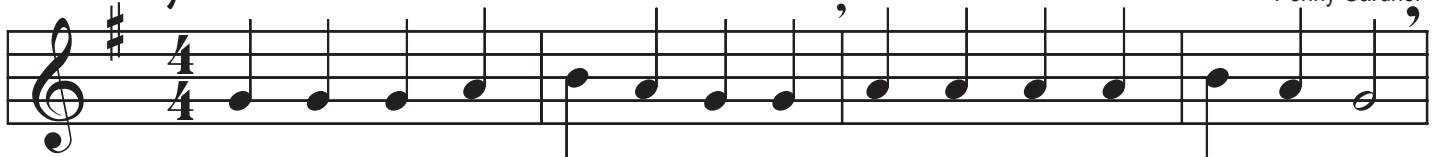


Donkeys and Carrots

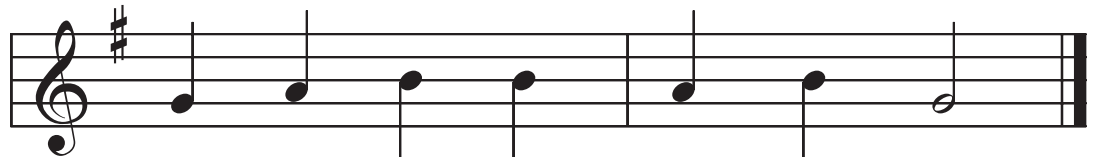
Traditional Welsh lullaby
